

C. B. Hayes, Former Grinnellian, Dies In Des Moines

Charles B. Hayes, former

Grinnell resident, died of a heart ailment Wednesday of this week at Iowa Methodist hospital in Des Moines. He had been in ill health for two years.

Mr. and Mrs. Hayes were residents of Grinnell about 20 years ago, after which they moved to Des Moines, where he served as stock superintendent for the International Harvester company until June of last year, when he retired. Hayes was 66 years of age at the time of death. In Grinnell he was also with the implement organization.

In 1931 Hayes was worshipful master of Hermon Lodge, Grinnell Masonic lodge. In 1953-1954 he was grand master of Iowa Masons.

Funeral services have been set for Saturday, Sept. 22, at the Consistory temple at Sixth Avenue and Park in Des Moines. The hour of services is 1:30 o'clock.

Several Grinnell Masons are planning to attend the funeral.
