## Hendrickson rites Friday

Marie Hendrickson, 74, of Newburg died Tuesday evening, Nov. 4, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10:30 a.m. Friday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Revs. Peter and Allyson Sawtell of the Newburg-Chester Parish, United Church of Christ, officiating.
