Clarice Nelson Henry, 89, of Grinnell died of complications from Parkinson's disease Sunday, Oct. 31, at the Mayflower.

Funeral services were conducted Wednesday at Hamilton's Funeral Home in Des Moines, with burial in Masonic Cemetery there.
