Therald J. Henry, 78, of Arlington, Texas, formerly of Brooklyn and Grinnell, died Sunday, June 26, at Skiff Medical Center in Newton.

Funeral services and burial will be in Arlington. There will be no local visitation or services.

The son of Joseph P. and Barbara Caroline McFerren Henry, he was born April 15, 1916, in rural Brooklyn. He received his education in a rural school and in Montezuma.
