Anna B. Herrick

Anna B. Herrick, of Sylvan, Washington, died at the Tacoma General hospital, Tacoma, Wash., May 27, 1917, of rheumatismal hemorrhage, after an illness of two weeks.

Anna Herrick was born in Elyria, Ohio, 1860, and moved with her parents to Grinnell, Iowa, in 1871, where she lived until the family moved to Sylvan, Wash., in 1889. She has all these years served in every way possible the community and the church of which she was a member. She held many positions of trust in church and community, being one of the few ever ready to do more than her part. She was at the time of her death one of the trustees of the Congregational Church, also treasurer of the church and of the ladies' society, and a member of the Women's State Missionary Board, having been a member of this board for the past ten years.
