

Herzberg, hurt in crash, dies

Gary E. Herzberg, 30, of Rte. 4, Grinnell, died Sunday morning at University Hospitals in Iowa City of injuries he sustained in a tractor accident the morning of May 31.

He had been hospitalized in critical condition since the accident.

Funeral services were held at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday at the Malcom Trinity American Lutheran Church, with the Rev. Gerald F. Brown officiating. Music was provided by Carol Hall, organist, and Robert and Marlene Toney, vocalists. Pallbearers were Donald Ahrens, Ronald DeBondt, Darryl Hull, Larry Iverson, Eldon Snook and Carroll Schacht. Flower bearers were Calvin and Rosemary Lyle and Dan and Ivy Hanson. Burial was at the Malcom Trinity Cemetery.

The son of Robert A. and Lorna J. Hendrickson Herzberg, he was born Sept. 6, 1947, at Grinnell. He attended rural schools near the family farm home in Chester Township and near Laurel. He was graduated from SEMCO High School in 1965, and he received his B.S. degree in animal science from Iowa State University in 1969.

On June 15, 1969, he was married to Charlotte A. Plum in Malcom. The couple lived in Cedar Falls for eight years where Mr. Herzberg was associated with the sales department of the Clay Equipment Co. They moved to their home southeast of Grinnell in January 1977.

Mr. Herzberg was a member of the Trinity American Lutheran Church, where he served as a sponsor of the Luther League and a member of the church choir. He was vice president of the Poweshiek County 4-H Fair Board, and was a member of the 4-H Fair Judging Committee, the Iowa Pork Producers, the Poweshiek County Farm Bureau, the American Animal Science Association, the American Bowling Congress, the Block and Bridle Club at Iowa State University, and softball teams with the Grinnell Parks and Recreation Department.

Survivors include his wife, Charlotte; two daughters, Beth Lynn, 2, and Anne Selina, 5 weeks; his parents, Robert and Lorna Herzberg of Grinnell; a sister, Mrs. Larry (Dianne) Jensen of Coon Rapids; a brother, Richard A. Herzberg of Grinnell; his paternal grandmother, Mrs. Albert Herzberg of Quincy, Calif.; and his maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Lester Hendrickson of Grinnell.
