Thelma L. Hill, 85, of Kellogg died Friday, Feb. 17, at Embassy Manor Care Center in Newton. 89

Services were conducted Tuesday at the Kellogg Christian Church, with the Rev. John Claussen officiating. Burial was in Our Silent City Cemetery at Kellogg.

The daughter of Franklin Howard and Lucy Starr McBrum, she was born Sept. 21, 1903, at Laurel. She attended Drake University and Iowa State Teachers College.
