Schedule Friday Funeral Rites For Walter Hink, 68

Walter Hink, 68, Grinnell, died at a local hospital Wednesday morning.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Friday at the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. L. H. Streich, pastor of St John's Lutheran church officiating. Music will be provided by Mrs. Waldo Johnson at the organ.

Pallbearers will be Raymond Cleland, Paul Heinle, Delmar Luttmann, Lester Luttmann, Floyd Puls, and Walter Puls. Burial will be in Trinity Lutheran cemetery.

Mr. Hink was born April 23rd, 1891, in Chester township, the son of John and Maria Wanner Hink. He was baptized and confirmed at Trinity American Lutheran church and received his early education in the Chester township schools. He had lived in the Grinnell area all of his life and had farmed until his retirement.

On March 24, 1914, he was united in marriage with Eleanor Heinle and to this union were born five children: Mrs. David (Wilma) MacKnight of White Bear Lake, Minn.; Mrs. Cleland (Alicc) Freeborn of Montezuma; Lois Hink of Woodward; Mrs. Howard (Betty) Jones of Des Moines; and Mrs. Jorgen (Doris) Hjorth of Pasadena, Calif.

Also surviving are his five grandchildren and one brother, Charles Hink of Grinnell. His wife Ella preceded him in death in May of 1949. In December of 1950 he was united in marriage with Frances Lynch and she preceded him in death in February of 1954.
