## Rites Today For Mrs. I. L. Hinshaw, Kellogg Resident

Mrs. Irvin L. (Izora Lovega) Hinshaw, 84, longtime Kellogg resident, died Tuesday morning at her home.

Funeral services were to be held this afternoon (Thursday) from the Toland funeral home at Newton with the Rev. Robert Miller, pastor of the Kellogg Christian church, officiating. Pallbearers were her grandsons, David Springer, Jr., Robert Hinshaw, William Hinshaw, Dean Hammer, Carroll Hammer and Michael Hinshaw.

Burial was in Center Friends cemetery northeast of Newton.

The daughter of Homer and Jane Irish Benson she was born Apr. 12th 1880, at Kellogg and attended the Jasper county schools. She was married to Irvin L. (Ted) Hinshaw on Dec. 29th, 1901.

With the exception of 14 years in Missouri, Mrs. Hinshaw spent her entire life in the Kellogg community.
