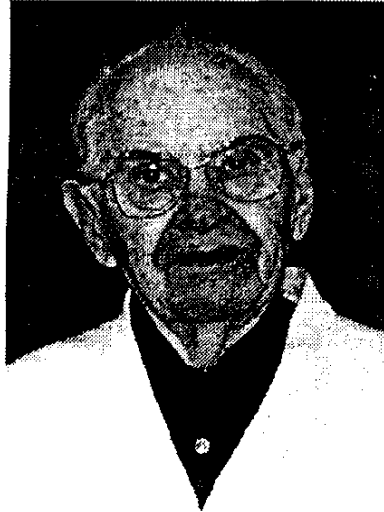


Alex Hofferber



Alex Hofferber, 92, of the Mayflower Home died Tuesday, June 16, at the Mayflower Health Care Center.

A memorial service will be conducted at 2 p.m. Friday at the Mayflower's Carman Center. Graveside services will be conducted at Cedar Memorial Cemetery, Cedar Rapids.

Born Nov. 7, 1905, in Lincoln, Neb., he was the son of George and Marie Hofferber.

After graduating from high school, he attended the University of Iowa for two years. He worked for four years in California, opening and managing stores in the Saunders Grocery chain. He then moved to Cedar Rapids and began a 27-year career at LaPlante Choate/Allis Chalmers. Following his retirement, he worked as a Linn County court bailiff for six years before moving to the Mayflower in 1977.

Mr. Hofferber was a lifetime member of Mizpah Masonic Lodge. He was president of the Mayflower Men's Club for two years. He served as church Sunday school superintendent and on the board of trustees at First Congregational Church in Cedar Rapids.

He is survived by his wife of 60 years, F. Janette Hofferber; one daughter, Mary Healy of Merrimac, Wis.; one son, George of Frederick, Md.; one sister, Irina Pappenfus of Rockwall, Texas; four grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren.
