

Arthur Hoksbergen ¹⁴⁻¹² 1942

Arthur Hoksbergen, 79, of Pella died Friday, Oct. 26, at Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines of injuries he sustained in a traffic accident Oct. 24 near Pella.

Funeral services were conducted Tuesday at the Third Reformed Church of Pella, with the Rev. Delmar D. Thiesse officiating. Burial was in Graceland Cemetery, Pella.

The son of Andrew and Anna Van Gorp Hoksbergen, he was born March 20, 1911, on a farm southeast of Pella. He attended Pleasant View School near Pella, and then attended high school in Pella.

He was married to Marie Van Gorp Feb. 22, 1935, in Pella. The couple lived in the Sandridge area for three years before moving to the Lower Grove area east of Pella in 1939. They farmed there.

Following the death of his wife in 1959, Mr. Hoksbergen was employed at the Rolscreen Co. in Pella for 10 years.

On Sept. 8, 1967, he was married to Martha Van Dyke at Pella where the couple continued to live.

Mr. Hoksbergen is survived by his wife; four children, Ken of Grinnell, Joyce Hackert of Pella, Wanda Bokhoven of Grand Rapids, Mich., and Karen Levison of North Oaks, Minn.; 14 grandchildren; eight grandchildren; three stepsons, Glenn Van Dyke of Scarsboro, Keith Van Dyke of Broomfield, Colo., and Marvin Van Dyke of Sully; nine step-grandchildren; one step-great-grandchild; and three sisters, Irene DeKock, Elizabeth Aalbers and Faye Bogaards, all of Pella.
