**Martin Hollmann
Charter Member
Of Farm Bureau**

Funeral services for Martin S. Hollmann, a long-time resident of the Malcom area and a charter member of the Poweshiek county Farm Bureau, were held at 2 p.m. Oct. 30 at the Steffy Funeral Home, conducted by the Rev. Frank Jacobs. Miss Alice Underwood played the funeral selections and accompanied soloists Mrs. Nellie Farley and Mrs. Virgil Sherwood.

Martin S. Hollmann, son of Christ John Hollmann and Lezete Bartel Hollmann, was born near Washington, Mo., Nov. 9, 1885, and died Oct. 26, at the age of 76 years, 11 months and 16 days. He lived his early life near Washington, Mo., until he came to the Malcom community in 1910.

He was married to Addie B. Royce on Dec. 24, 1913. They lived in the present home until the time of Mr. Hollmann's death. To this marriage, three sons were born. Royce, of Farmington, N.M., Edward, Montezuma, and Harold of the home.

Mr. Hollmann has been a farmer on his farm for the past 50 years. He has served his community as school director and was a charter member of the Farm Bureau. He has been in declining health for a number of years. He was a good citizen, good farmer and a faithful husband and father.
