Gilman man dies in crash

A Gilman man died Wednesday of injuries sustained in a two-car crash south of Marshalltown on Highway 14.

Killed was Richard R. Holmes, 27, whose northbound car collided head-on with a car driven by Ray Yandell, 59, of Marshalltown. The accident occurred shortly after 6 p.m.

Yandell received minor injuries and was treated at a Marshalltown Hospital.

Funeral services for Richard Holmes were held at 1:30 p.m.

Saturday at the Gilman Community Church. Burial was at Prairie View Cemetery, with the Estel-Perrin Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

He had been employed at the Iowa Electric Light and Power Co. for the past eight years. He
