

Harry Hopkins Services Held

Harry H. Hopkins, 88, of Brooklyn, died early Saturday morning in the Brookhaven Nursing Home in Brooklyn where he had been a resident the past three years.

He was born May 31, 1885, near Harrisonburg, Va., the son of Mr. and Mrs. William Newton Hopkins. He came to Iowa in 1914. He worked for various farmers for several years. For over 35 years he made his home with Mr. and Mrs. G.W. Manatt of Brooklyn. Mr. Hopkins was a 50-year member of Knights of Pythias Poweshiek Lodge 198.

He is survived by one brother, Bruce Hopkins of Morris, Ill. He was preceded by his parents, seven sisters and two brothers.
