

## Arthur N. Hough

Arthur N. Hough, 87, of Mesa, Ariz., a former editor of The Grinnell Herald-Register, died Oct. 30 in Mesa.

Funeral services were conducted Nov. 5, in Cedar Rapids, with burial in Linwood Cemetery there.

He was the son of Leigh and Una Nicholson Hough and was born May 16, 1910, in Newton. He was a 1932 graduate of Grinnell College.

He was married to Helen Bailey June 1, 1935. She died in 1959. He was married to Margaret Swope June 12, 1965.

Mr. Hough worked as a journalist and photographer for over 50 years. He was a reporter, sports editor and city editor of The Newton Daily News from 1933 to 1938 and edited The Herald-Register from 1946 to 1948. He was a writer, photographer and photo editor of The Cedar Rapids Gazette from 1961 until he retired in 1975.

Surviving are his wife; two daughters, Kathryn Rymer of Guam and Diana Schandling of Spring Valley, N.Y.; one son, Stephen of San Marcos, Calif.; one sister, Rosslyn Ashcraft of Newton; 10 grandchildren; and seven great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents and his first wife, Helen.
