**Harvey Howell services held**

Harvey P. Howell, 87, of Anacortes, Wash., formerly of Grinnell, died June 16 at Island Hospital in Anacortes.

Funeral services were held June 21 at the Evans and Engdahl Funeral Chapel in Anacortes with burial at the Fernhill Cemetery in Anacortes.

He was born in Jasper County March 24, 1895. He graduated from Grinnell High School in 1914 and taught rural school for 2½ years before being called into the Army in World War I in which he served in France. He was married to Gladys Turner March 24, 1920, in Lynnville and farmed in the Grinnell area for 30 years,

after which he worked at the Grinnell Shoe Factory, retiring in 1962. In 1966 he moved to Anacortes where he spent the remainder of his life.

He was an active member of Westfield Church while residing here and served as Sunday School superintendent for many years. He was a member of World War I Veterans' Barracks 2066 of Anacortes and served several years as chaplain.

He is survived by his wife Gladys; two sons, Kenneth of Sedro-Woolley, Wash., and Charles of Green Forest, Ark.; and several grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
