Mrs. Earl Hubbard Dies At Chariton

A former Grinnell resident, Mrs. Earl (Teresa) Hubbard succumbed Friday at a hospital in Chariton.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m., Apr. 15th, from the Beardsley Funeral Home at Chariton with the Rev. John Bauserman officiating. Interment will be in the Chariton cemetery.

Born June 24th, 1901, in Meigs County, Ohio, she attended elementary school there and Central high school at Columbus, Ohio. She was a graduate of Mann's Business College at Columbus and was a stenographer for Ohio State University, Iowa State University, and for her husband the remainder of her active life.

She was married to Earl Douglas Hubbard on Mar. 16th, 1929, and to this union was born one daughter, Betty Teresa Cooper. Dr. Hubbard practiced veterinary medicine in Grinnell for many years, but a number of years ago accepted a position with the Veterinary Medical Research Institute at Iowa State University.

Preceding her in death were her parents, a younger infant sister, and her daughter in 1959.

Survivors include her husband, Earl; a brother, Norman Russell of Atlanta, Ga.; a sister, Verne Hysell of Pomroy, Ohio; and three nieces and two nephews.

Mrs. Hubbard was a member of the Methodist church of Grinnell.
