Former Resident Inez Bailey Huff Dies In Oregon

Inez Evelyn Huff, 46, former Grinnell resident, died Monday at Medford, Ore., following an extended illness.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. next Monday at the James-Schainske Funeral Home with the Rev. Kenneth Headland officiating. Interment will be in Hazelwood cemetery.

The daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Manzel Bailey, she was born July 17th, 1913, in the Bethel community near Grinnell. She attended the rural schools in that vicinity and was a graduate of Grinnell high school and attended Grinnell college. She was a member of the Bethel Methodist church.

On July 5th, 1936, she was united in marriage with Glenn Huff at the Little Brown church at Nashua. They lived in Grinnell for a number of years and during World War II moved to the west coast. They lived in Alaska for several years and in 1957 moved to Medford, Ore., and operated a home appliance store.

Mrs. Huff is survived by her husband, Glenn; her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Manzel Bailey of Grinnell; a sister, Mrs. Carol Sammon of Grinnell; a brother, Bernard A. Bailey of Long Beach, Calif.; and two nephews and a niece.
