Mrs. Wilhelmina Huff, widow of James B. Huff, died Wednesday evening at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Gordon Van Donselaar of Grinnell. She had not been in good health since last November.

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Saturday at the Northside Friends church with the Rev. Kenneth Headland officiating, assisted by Mrs. Huff's son-in-law, the Rev. Eugene McClure of Pisgah. Burial will be in Hazelwood cemetery. Friends may call at the Smith Funeral Home.

She was the daughter of Augustus and Mary Jane O'Neill and was born on May 7th, 1864 at Sibley. Most of her younger years were spent at Clear Lake where she attended local schools. On Oct. 3rd, 1903, she was united in marriage with James Bertram Huff.
