Chester M. Hulin, 85, of rural Gilman died Friday, Aug. 6, at St. Francis Manor in Grinnell.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday at the Gilman United Church of Christ, with the Rev. Angie Hulin officiating. Organist will be Janice Everts, and soloist will be Jim Judkins. Casket bearers will be Kim Hulin, Laurie Vaughan, Russ Thomas, Forrest Hulin, Cathy Thomas and Kristy Buchanan.
