**Harry Hulín**  
**Services Held**

Funeral services for Harry Hulín, 89, of Gilman, who died Tuesday morning at the Lutheran Nursing Home in Cedar Falls, were held at 10:30 a.m. today (Thursday) at Pursel-Davis Chapel in Marshalltown. Burial was in Prairieview Cemetery, Gilman.

Mr. Hulín, a retired mail carrier, was born at Gilman Oct. 1, 1882, the son of Oliver and Elizabeth Hulín. He was married to Malinda Harris in LeGrand in 1907, the same year he was appointed a rural mail carrier. He retired in 1944.

Mr. Hulín was a charter member of the Marshall County Rural Farmers Association, was a member of GPOE No. 312, and was active in the Gilman United Methodist Church.
