
Henry A. Hulse 3-15-1932 Passes Away

Henry A. Hulse, who died at his home at 1405 Third avenue Saturday morning, was born Dec. 23, 1886, northeast of Brooklyn, Iowa. He was a son of Peter and Emma Hulse. He was married to Mabel Wheeler in 1912 in St. Louis, Mo. He lived in Grinnell from 1920-22, and from 1926 until his death.
