Kenneth O. Hummell.

Kenneth O. Hummell departed this life at his home six miles northwest of Grinnell, Wednesday morning at 9 o'clock, aged 32 years, 3 months and 23 days.

The sad news of his death was a severe shock not only to his family, but his many friends as he was beloved by all who knew him.

He was a strong character, prompt in action, but often slow to speak, thinking much and hiding his time; not forward to obtrude his counsel, but giving his opinions, when sought or needed in few words—clear, comprehensive. Unquestionably he would have gone to his grave a loving husband, a father, a soul desiring the most generous deeds and repute of the noblest of all virtues, justice and impartiality, but it was for those who knew him best to appreciate him in the business of his nature, in the unswerving simplicity of his character, in the persistence of his labor.

He was born Dec. 14th, 1881, in Polk county, Iowa, and was united in marriage to Cora L. Reynolds Dec. 9th, 1907. He leaves to mourn his loss, his wife and little son, Kenneth, aged 7 years. Also his father and mother, Mr. and Mrs. Seth Hummell, three brothers, Frank M., Chester Y. and Rufus S., one sister, Mrs. Fred Walker.
