

Robert Hunt services held

Robert L. Hunt Jr., 63, of Cedar Rapids, formerly of Grinnell, died Monday, Jan. 6, at St. Luke's Hospital in Cedar Rapids.

Funeral services were conducted at 11 a.m. Thursday at Turner Chapel West in Cedar Rapids, with Dr. Richard M. Newhall of St. Paul's United Methodist Church officiating. Burial was in Hazelwood Cemetery, Grinnell.

A memorial fund has been established.

He was born on May 4, 1922, in Omaha, Neb. On June 26, 1955, he was married to Wanda Mackin in Grinnell. Mr. Hunt was owner and operator of Hunt Claim Service in Cedar

Rapids until he sold the business in 1976. He then conducted insurance investigations on private aircraft claims.

He was a member of the First Lutheran Church, Organized Flying Adjusters and Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association. He served as a fighter pilot with the Army Air Corps during World War II and the Korean conflict.

Survivors include his wife; two sons, Randall S. and Jeffrey R., both of Cedar Rapids; one grandson; and two sisters, Nettie Johnson of Grinnell and Isabelle Pieper of Littleton, Colo.
