

**Mrs. Elsie Hunter
Died On Sunday Eve;
Funeral Tuesday 1952**

Mrs. Elsie Harriet Hunter, wife of Allen Hunter, of 515 Main street, passed away Sunday evening in a local hospital, aged 67 years, 4 months and 27 days following a serious operation. She had been a resident of Grinnell for 31 years.
