## Conduct Rites Saturday For Thomas Hunter

Funeral services for Thomas Hunter, 32, of Rte. 2, Grinnell, were held Saturday afternoon from the James-Schalinske Funeral Home with Dr. G. S. Bruland, pastor of the Methodist church, officiating.

Mr. Hunter died at his home last Thursday forenoon.

Vocal music at the services was furnished by Mrs. Noel Taylor, accompanied by Mrs. Kathleen Heffner at the organ. Pallbearers were Earl Bryan, Robert T. Ashow, Raymond Bahrenfuss, Willard Jackson, Robert W. Ashow and Paul Krumm.

Interment was in Hazelwood cemetery.

The son of George and Christina Cave Hunter, he was born on Jan. 1st, 1879, at Rapid City, Ill. With the exception of some years spent in Kansas, he lived in the Grinnell community after coming here with his parents as a youth.

He was united in marriage with Fanny Deviney on Feb. 16th, 1906, and they farmed southwest of Grinnell.

Mr. Hunter is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Roy (Florence) Hammond of Davenport; and four brothers, Hugh, James, John, and Richard, all of Grinnell.

He was preceded in death by his wife on Dec. 2nd, 1956, his

parents, and two brothers.

Mr. Hunter was a member of the Methodist church.
