Wellknown Grinnell Woman Died Saturday Afternoon.

Anna Jerusha Knapp was born in Berry county, Michigan, January 6, 1866, and passed away at her home here Saturday afternoon, August 19, at 7:30 o'clock, after an illness of only two days. At the time of her death she was 56 years, 7 months and 13 days old. She lived in Berry county with her parents until she was 9 years of age at which time they moved to Indiana and stayed one year. From that place they went to Hartford, Van Buren county, where they remained three years, moving from there to Covert where she lived for two years. While in Covert she was married in November of 1882 to Henry Leonard Hurd at the age of 16 years. After her marriage they moved to Grinnell, where they have since made their home.
