Henry, son of Margaret and Joseph Hutchinson, was born on a farm east of Montezuma, on April 27, 1890, and passed away in the Mahaska Hospital, Oskaloosa, August 5.

In his youth he attended rural school and helped with the farm work.

On March 31, 1915, he was united in marriage with Maude Gorsuch and to this union two sons were born. They lived on a farm until 1941 when they moved to Montezuma. Mrs. Hutchinson passed away in 1942.

Later, Mr. Hutchinson married Lois Tufford. She died in February, 1956.

On March 14, 1957, he was united in marriage with Gertrude Lowe.

Mr. Hutchinson was a member of the Presbyterian Church and a member of the Lafayette Lodge #52, A.F. & A.M. for the past 30 years.

He was preceded in death by two brothers, John and Frank.

He is survived by his wife, Gertrude; two sons, Maynard of Montezuma, and Wayne, of Spokane, Wash., four grandchildren; one brother, Ray, and one sister, Mrs. Myrtle Gorsuch.
