

Monte Cafe Operator Dies

Hutchinson Succumbs

Sunday at Card Party

Operator of the Monte Cafe in Montezuma for 30 years, John Hutchinson, 62, died of a heart attack Sunday just before 11 p.m. while attending a card party at the Truman Heishman place three miles north of Grinnell on 146.

Hutchinson had not been feeling well Sunday but prior to that had been in good health. He collapsed after other guests had left and was dead before a physician reached the Heishman home.

A lifelong resident of Montezuma, Hutchinson worked with his father as a carpenter before entering the cafe business at the corner location in Monte.

Surviving are his wife; a daughter, Mrs. Walter Willett of Tama, and three grandchildren; and two sisters, Margaret Shearer and Mary Atchinson, both of Des Moines.

Funeral arrangements had not been completed this morning. The body is at Steffy funeral home in Montezuma.
