Mr. Hutchinson services held

The Mass of the Resurrection for Kenneth W. Hutchinson, 60, of 1702 Fourth Ave., was celebrated at 10 a.m. today at St. Mary's Catholic Church.

Mr. Hutchinson died Sunday, March 19, at Grinnell General Hospital. Burial was at St. Mary's Cemetery at Maloy, with the Smith Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

The son of William and Sylvia Graves Hutchinson, he was born July 20, 1917, at Leon. He attended school in Leon and Osceola and in 1934 graduated from Mount Ayr High School. He attended Graceland College at Lamoni for one year, and for three years he majored in journalism at the University of Missouri at Columbia.

In 1938 he began working for Iowa Southern Utilities Co. He moved to Grinnell in 1949 and continued to work for Iowa Southern. He retired in 1974 because of a disability.

Mr. Hutchinson was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church and a life member of the Grinnell B.P.O. Elks Lodge No. 1266.

He was married to Eileen Shay at Maloy on Dec. 26, 1942.

He is survived by his wife; his children, William J. Hutch-
