

## Howard Hyde rites Wednesday

Howard F. Hyde, 86, of 1228 Main St. died Monday morning at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Hugh A. Shiveley, pastor of the First Baptist Church, officiating. Music was provided by Kathleen Herfner, organist, and Edward Bohstedt, vocalist. Pallbearers were Robert W. Asnov, Guilford L. Moore, William H. Mullan, Werner S. Plutar, Harold Stanley, and Warren Weaver. Burial was at Hazelwood Cemetery.

The son of Fremont and Nancy Smith Hyde, he was born April 8, 1890, in Scott County. He was a graduate of Grinnell High School and later attended Grinnell College.

On Sept. 1, 1915, he was married to Florence Parmenter in Grinnell. Following their marriage, Mr. and Mrs. Hyde farmed in the Maple Grove neighborhood until moving to Grinnell 20 years ago. Mr. Hyde was a member of the Grinnell First Baptist Church and had served as the church secretary, trustee and superintendent of the Sunday School. He was also a member of the former Grant Township School Board.

Survivors include his wife, Florence; a brother, George A. Hyde of Grinnell; a sister, Mrs. Crott Helen Pilgrim of Long Beach, Calif.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Mrs. George Lotta Evans.
