

Brooklyn Rites For Mrs. Iler^{#2}

Funeral services for Mrs. Florence Ryan Iler, 83, of Downers Grove, Ill., a former resident of Brooklyn and Montezuma, were held at 1 p.m. Wednesday at the Nevenhoven Funeral Home in Brooklyn. Mrs. Iler died Saturday in Downers Grove.

The Rev. J. Arthur Eveland, pastor of the Grace United Methodist Church, officiated. Organist was Mrs. Lowell Sherwood, and pallbearers included Lyle Ryan, James Griffith, Harlan Mueller, Francis Cannon, Jerry Wenger, and Max Ryan. Burial was in the I.O.O.F. Cemetery, Brooklyn.
