Former Resident Of Malcom Area Dies In California

MALCOM, (Special)—Graveside services were held at 2 p.m. Saturday, March 11 at Memory Garden Memorial Park Cemetery, Brea, Calif. for Benjamin L. Jackson, a former Malcom resident. H. F. Moritz Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements. The Rev. Leslie Ross, pastor of the first Methodist Church officiated.

Mr. Jackson was born July 4, 1882 in Indiana. He died in a local hospital in Montebello, Calif. March 8 after a three-week illness. He had spent the last twenty years in California.

Mr. Jackson was employed as a Security Guard for CMO Protection Service for eight years before his retirement.

He was preceded in death by his parents and several brothers, and his wife, Alice Mae Shannon Jackson, the mother of his children, who died in 1935.
