**Young Married Woman Yields to
Influenza While Caring for
Her Mother.**

Mrs. Edward S. Jackson, of Strawberry Point, Iowa, died Sunday evening at seven o'clock, at the home of her mother, Mrs. Rhoda Bayley, at 1023 Park street. The influenza followed by pneumonia was the cause of her death.

Mrs. Jackson was called to Grinnell early in December to care for her mother and sister who were suffering from the influenza and while with them contracted the disease herself. Both her mother and sister were very sick and have not fully recovered themselves as yet.

Genevieve Bayley was born in Grinnell on November 16, 1889, and made her home here until the time of her marriage. She attended both Grinnell high school and Grinnell College and taught in the high school at Montezuma for a short time.

Mr. Jackson, who is a Montezuma boy, was called from Strawberry Point last Friday, coming at once. Private funeral services will be conducted at the grave by Reverend J. M. Brown at 2:30 this afternoon.
