Theodric Jacobs.

Theodric Price Jacobs, the fourth child of a family of ten, was born in Loudon Co., Virginia, October 16, 1836, and died July 15, 1918 at the home of his daughter, Mrs. M. C. Satchell, at the age of 82 years, 8 months and 15 days.

At the age of nineteen he came west with his parents locating at Shawwood, Ill.

In 1869 he was united in marriage to Miss Sarah E. Killin and located at Deep River, Iowa, the remainder of his active life was spent on a farm in Poweshiek county.

In 1900 he with his family moved to Grinnell where he spent the remainder of his life.

Long in manhood he united with the Methodist Episcopal church of which he was a faithful member.

The deceased is survived by a wife and seven children, Mrs. M. C. Satchell, W. E., and H. P. Jacobs of this city, Joseph M. Jacobs, of Temple, Colo., Mrs. H. R. Higgins, Gray, Ia., Mrs. A. L. Coburn, of Brockton, Ia., and H. L. Jacobs of Des Moines, one son, L. E. Jacobs, having preceded his father.

Besides the wife and children he is survived by two brothers, T. F. Jacobs of Clarion and W. W. Jacobs of New London, Ia.
