James dies in Seattle

Charles M. James, 94, a retired Naval captain who attended Grinnell College near the turn of the century, died Friday, July 18, at Greenwood Crest House Nursing Home in Seattle.

Born Oct. 24, 1885, in Independence, Kan., he moved with his family to Iowa at a young age. He studied at the Grinnell Academy and was a staunch friend of the college,

particularly of the class of 1907.

Survivors include two sons, Ricker James of Seattle and John James of Long Island, N.Y.; and a daughter, Marjorie Reinhart of Redwood, Calif.

Military memorial services were held July 26 at 11 a.m. at Mt. Pleasant Cemetery in Seattle.
