Gerrit C. Jansen, 77, died Friday morning, May 4, at the Mahaska County Hospital in Oskaloosa.

Funeral services for Gerrit Jansen were held Monday at the Sully Christian Reformed Church. The Rev. Siebert Kramer, pastor of the church, and the Rev. Daniel Hakken, pastor of the Sully Reformed Church, conducted the services. Burial was in the Sully Cemetery.

Born Oct. 19, 1901 in Sully, he was the son of Cornelius and Mary Plate Jansen. He married Elizabeth Fopma on Dec. 5, 1922, in Sully.

He was a longtime Sully area farmer, and a resident of Sully since 1962.
