## Funeral Services Held For Alma Jantzen

Funeral services were held Monday, March 23, in Tama for Mrs. Leonard (Alma) Jantzen, 61, wife of a Tama police officer. Mrs. Jantzen had died March 20 at Marshalltown Community Hospital East where she had been a patient since Dec. 29.

The Rev. Carroll Usher, Methodist minister, officiated at the services. Burial was in Sheridan cemetery.

The daughter of Hans and Bertha Frederichs Sieck, Mrs. Jantzen was born June 28, 1908, in Tama, Iowa. She attended school in Tama County.

On Oct. 10, 1925, she married Leonard Jantzen of Poweshick County. Following their marriage, the couple lived on farms in the Sheridan community in Poweshick County.

In 1953, the Jantzens moved to Tama and for the last 17 years she had been employed at the Tama Nursing Home.

Mrs. Jantzen was a member of the Methodist church in Sheridan community and the Eagles Auxiliary in Tama.

Survivors include her husband, Leonard; three sons—Harold of Malcom, Lyle of Montour and Donald of Traer; six grandchildren including Jerry and Allen Jantzen of Malcom; and a brother Franz of Marion.

Mrs. Jantzen was preceded in death by a daughter, Betty; a brother, Rudolph Sieck; and her parents.
