World War Veteran Laid to Rest in
Hazelwood.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday afternoon by Rev. E. M. Vitum from the home of Mrs. Mattie Barnes for Earl Jenkins who passed away Thursday morning at the Community Hospital after a serious illness of three weeks. Bearers were six Legion comrades.

William Earl Jenkins, son of Thomas and Myrtle Jenkins, was born December 29, 1887 in Grinnell, Iowa, and died July 1, 1935. He served on the Mexican border before the World War and was also in service during the war. He leaves to mourn his loss, his mother and father; three sisters, Marjorie of Des Moines and Louise and Edith of Grinnell; three brothers, Eugene, Orville and Joe of Grinnell. Burial was made in Hazelwood.
