Mrs. Jentzen Dies In Local Hospital

Mrs. Pauline Jentzen, 87, of 1019 Summer St., died Wednesday evening at a local hospital, following an extended illness.

The daughter of John C. and Sophia Puls Tiedemann, she was born on May 6, 1880 at Princeton, Ill. She attended Princeton public schools. On June 29, 1898 she was united in marriage to Charles Jentzen at her parents home east of Grinnell. Following their marriage the couple farmed in the Marshalltown community for 20 years.

Since 1932 Mrs. Jentzen has lived in Grinnell. She was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church.

Survivors include one brother, Lou Tiedemann of Grinnell; two sisters, Mrs. Leda Tschopp of Marshalltown and Mrs. Ella Gropfer of Grinnell; and several nieces and nephews.

Mrs. Jentzen was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Charles; two brothers, John and Fred Tiedemann; and three sisters, Mrs. Mary Mitelman and Christine and Emma Jentzen.
