Deverne Johnson, son of Henry Johnson of this city, died at his home near Glenville, Minn., on Saturday, January 25, at the age of 30 years, 4 months and 8 days after a short illness from influenza which developed into pneumonia. Funeral services were held at the home of his brother, Jervis Johnson, near Lynnvile, Monday.

The deceased was born on a farm near Lynnvile and spent most of his life in this vicinity. After his marriage to Miss Lillian Cook of Seattle, Washington, he located on the home place near Lynnvile but later moved to the Jenkins farm near the junction south of Grinnell. About three years ago he purchased a farm near Glenville, Minn., living there until his untimely death. He was sick only one week from the influenza which speedily developed into pneumonia.

He is survived by his wife, two children, Charlott Marjory and Elizabeth May, his father, Henry Johnson of this city, two brothers and a sister.
