MRS. GEORGE M. JOHNSON.

Emma Ann Watson, second daughter of Jesse and Jane Watson was born in Sugar Creek township on April 2, 1862, where she grew to womanhood, spending her entire life on the same farm.

On June 23, 1881, she was united in marriage to George M. Johnson. To this union was born 12 children: Charles W., Edgar P., Myrtle, Alpha, Fred M., Albert L., Harry L., Nettie, Edna, George Junior and two having preceeded her in infancy.
