Funeral Services Held For Kellogg Resident

Funeral services were held at 3:30 p.m. yesterday (Wednesday) in the Johnson Chapel for Nathaniel A. Johnson, 77, of Kellogg, a lifelong resident of Jasper County, who died Saturday in Veterans Hospital in Des Moines.

The Rev. W. H. Lindquist, pastor of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Kellogg, officiated at the services. Burial was in Our Silent City Cemetery in Kellogg.

The son of John P. and Augusta W. Larson Johnson, Mr. Johnson was born April 30, 1891 in Kellogg. He attended Kellogg schools.

A farmer and a carpenter, Mr. Johnson lived in Kellogg all of his life except for three years when he lived in Newton. He was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church and the Kellogg American Legion Post.

Survivors include one brother — Albin Johnson of Newton; two sisters — Mrs. Levi (Hilda) Kono and Mrs. George (Ellen) Redding, both of Kellogg; and a number of nieces and nephews. Mr. Johnson was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers and one sister.
