CARL CLINTON JONES

Carl Clinton Jones, son of Benjamin and Dorothea Jones, was born in Grinnell, Iowa, on November 3, 1898. He attended the Grinnell Public schools and the First Baptist church at 4th and Park. He was a member of the Knights of Pythias.

On June 12, 1919, at Des Moines, he was united in marriage with Gladys Appleby of Grinnell. To this union was born one daughter, Barbara.

Mr. Jones began working for the railroad near Grinnell and in 1932 he moved to Newton, Iowa where the family has made its home ever since. At the time of his death he had worked with the railroad for nearly 40 years. He was preceded in death by his parents, one brother, and one sister.

Carl Jones passed away very suddenly last Thursday morning, September 27, 1956 at Newton, nearly 58 years of age. He leaves to mourn his passing his companion, Gladys Appleby Jones, one daughter Mrs. Raiph (Barbara) Creger, Little Rock, Arkansas, and one grandson, Carl Clinton Creger.
