Harold L. Jones, 76, of Grinnell died of a respiratory ailment Saturday, Feb. 17, at Veterans Medical Center in Des Moines.

Funeral services were conducted Thursday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Ken Wallace, pastor of the Newburg-Chester Congregational Church, officiating. Casket bearers were Bob Dale, Stephan Jones, Chuck McAtee, Dean McClelland, Marvin Steenhoek and Vic White.
