LeRoy T. Kaiser, 51, of Rte. 1, Grinnell, died at his home early Friday morning of an apparent heart attack.

The Mass of the Resurrection was celebrated at 10 a.m. Monday at St. Mary's Catholic Church, with the Rev. Harry N. Linnenbrink, pastor of the church, officiating. Organist was Kathleen Heffner, and pallbearers were John Collins, Jim Garrison, Amos Maney, Edwin Peterson, Robert L. Toney and James Ulm. Flower bearers were Mr. and Mrs. George Brown.

The Scripture service was held at 8 p.m. Sunday at the Smith Funeral Home. Burial was in the Calvary Section of Hazelwood Cemetery.

The son of LeRoy and Helen Rolwicz Kaiser, he was born April 19, 1925, at Jersey City, N.J. He attended schools in Jersey City and later attended Rutgers University and Valparaiso Technical School.

He was married to Rita Halloran on Jan. 10, 1948, in Valparaiso, Ind. Mr. Kaiser was employed by General Telephone Co. for 29 years in Valparaiso, LaFayette and Connersville, Ind., before coming to Grinnell in 1959.

He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church and B.P.O. Elks Lodge No. 1266 in Grinnell.

Survivors include his wife, Rita; his parents, LeRoy and Helen Kaiser of Jersey City; and a brother, George R. Kaiser of Neptune, N.J.
