She was born Sept. 29, 1898, in Stuttgart and attended school there. On Sept. 30, 1922, she was married to Gustave Kalfass at Stuttgart. Following their marriage, they continued to live in Germany until moving to the U.S. in 1923. They lived in Cleveland, Ohio, for 19 years and moved to Grinnell in 1947. Mr. and Mrs. Kalfass were employed by the food service at Grinnell College. Mr. Kalfass died in 1963, and Mrs. Kalfass returned to Germany.

There are no immediate survivors.
