Memorials To John Kaufman in Michigan

Mr. and Mrs. Charles L. Kaufman returned Tuesday from their Frankfort, Michigan, summer home. On Oct. 7, they attended a church service at the First Methodist Church in Midland, Mich., at which service a window was dedicated in memory of their son, John D. Kaufman, who died June 9, 1970. Also on Oct. 18 a Midland city park was renamed "The John D. Kaufman Memorial Park" as a memorial to his civic services.

John graduated from Grinnell High School in 1949, where he was an honor student, a recipient of a Westinghouse Science Honor Scholarship and during these years he became an Eagle Scout. His church work in Grinnell is especially remembered because he instituted "Christ's Work Day" which was later adopted in many churches. In 1952 he was graduated from Iowa State University.
