Thomas Keenan^{H.R.} Rites Conducted

Funeral services were held Saturday at the Smith Funeral Home for Thomas P. Keenan, 79, who died late Thursday morning after an illness of about six weeks.

The Rev. L. V. Kuebrich, pastor of St. Mary's Catholic church, officiated at the services. Pallbearers were Nigel Anderson, Russell Otcheck, Shirley Sisco, Bill Davenport, Perry Wilson and George Wilson. Burial was in Hazelwood cemetery.

He was born near the Oak Grove community south of Grinnell on April 29, 1920, and was united in marriage with Harriet Mae Watson on Jan. 12, 1921.

To this union four children were born: Maurice of Grinnell, Vincent of Newton, Mrs. Lois Olson of Harrison, Mont., and Bernard, who preceded him in death. His wife also preceded him in death in March 1938.

He is survived by his three children, eight grandchildren, and one brother, Dr. Edward Keenan of San Bernardino, Calif.

Mr. Keenan had lived his entire life in the Grinnell area and was employed as a plumber.
