Mr. Kelgor services held

Voersaa Kelgor, 79, of Kimballton, the father of Mary Lee Durr of Grinnell, died Monday, June 4, at the Jennie Edmondson Hospital in Council Bluffs.

Funeral services were conducted at 2 p.m. Thursday at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Kimballton, with the Revs. George Gerber and Richard Dahle officiating. Burial was in the Immanuel Lutheran Church Cemetery.

The son of Jens P. and Bergitte Voersaa Kelgor, he was born Nov. 29, 1905, at Audubon. Prior to coming to Kimballton, he operated bakery shops in Oakland, Calif., and Elk Horn, Iowa. He had also been in the restaurant and appliance business, had an insurance business in Elk Horn

and Kimballton, and owned and operated the Kimballton Hotel for many years. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge of Marne.
